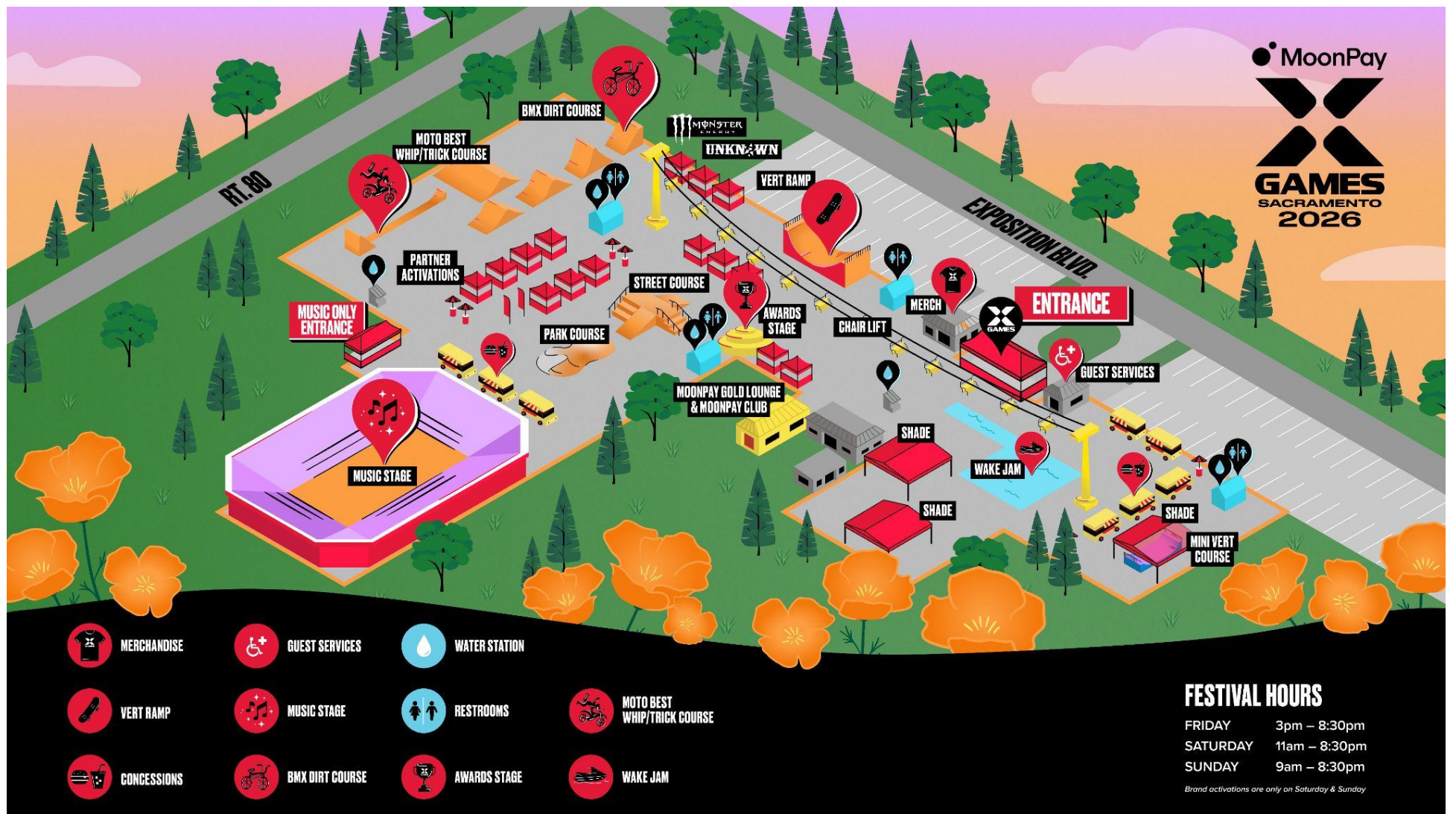

## X Games Event Policies

### EVENT POLICIES

- All attendees must possess a valid ticket for entry.
- Concert attendees should review ticket-specific requirements prior to arrival.
- Guests should arrive early to allow sufficient time for parking, entry, and security screening.
- The event schedule is available on [XGames.com](http://XGames.com) and is subject to change. Guests are encouraged to check for updates prior to arriving at the venue

### TICKET POLICIES

- A valid ticket is required for entry to X Games Sacramento. We strongly recommend purchasing tickets in advance at [xgames.com](http://xgames.com) as ticket availability on event days is not guaranteed.
- Children 5 and under are free with a ticketed adult.
- Attendees 14 and under must be accompanied by an adult 21+ to attend competition.
- Attendees under 18 must be accompanied by an adult 21+ to attend music performances.
- MoonPay X Games Sacramento 2026 is a rain-or-shine event. There are no refunds or ticket exchanges. Prices are subject to change without notice. Prices include all fees. Any applicable taxes and shipping will be added at checkout. Lineup subject to change.

### PROHIBITED ITEMS

- Large bags, small personal bags and backpacks unless they meet the specifications of California Exposition center clear bag policies displayed on Approved Bags list below. Parental bags are allowed as long as they are readily available for screening at entry.
- Weapons of any kind, including firearms, knives, and mace/pepper spray.
- Alcohol and all outside beverages (factory-sealed and empty personal water bottles are permitted, and water filling stations are provided).
- Coolers of any kind.
- Pets (with the exception of service dogs).
- Folding chairs, stools, or large umbrellas.
- Drones or unmanned aerial vehicles.
- Selfie sticks, laser pointers, and noisemakers (e.g., air horns, whistles).
- Illegal drugs, marijuana, cigarettes, and e-cigarettes (these are strictly enforced as non-smoking events).
